

Adolf Hitler biography

Adolf Hitler was TIME magazine's Man of the Year in 1938. He was Chancellor of Germany and Head of State as well as he was supreme commander of the military. Hitler was very skilled in giving emotional speeches and was a manipulator. He was a vegetarian and a non-smoker. He convinced the Germans that he was their savior from the economic depression, communism,

the Versailles Treaty, the Jews, and other handicapped, poor uneducated people. The Nazis helped Germans to eliminate them. Hitler and Eva were married the day before they died together.

Hitler was born on April 20, 1889 in the small town of Braunau am Inn, Austria. He was the third son and the fourth child of six. His father's name was Alois Hitler and his mother's name was Klara Polzi (Alois's third wife). Hitler had half siblings, and they came from his father's second wife. Hitler was a very good student in school until his father died when he was 13 years old. When he left school at 16 years old, he had no qualifications. Hitler's father was upset and wanted Hitler to become involved in government work, but Hitler wanted to become an artist. However, twice he was rejected by the Academy of Fine Arts, Vienna.

In July 1919, Hitler was appointed as police spy of Intelligence Commando. In 1920, Hitler joined the National Socialist German Worker Party as inspector Nazi. The Nazi party was for people who wanted the cancellation of the Versailles Treaty, and it was a very strong central government. But Hitler met the founder of the Nazi party whose name was Dietrich Eckart. Eckart became Hitler's mentor and taught him how to dress and speak. Before Hitler joined, they were only a few members and they did not function very well as a Nazi army. Right after Hitler became leader of the Nazi Party, many people joined the Nazi party because Hitler had a powerful ability to speak. He was very organized and put together an army called the Storm Troopers. They were seeking the people who supported the Allies in order to destroy

and kill these ones who wanted to disband the Nazis. On November 9, 1923, Hitler led more than 2,000 Storm Troopers to attack the Bavarian government, but he failed. Hitler, Eckart, the Nazi members, and Storm Troopers went to jail for treason for 5 years. During Hitler's stay in prison, he wrote the book, "Mein Kampf (My Struggle)" about planning for Germany's future and started to create his own beliefs. When Hitler got out of jail, he rebuilt the Nazi party. The party's new name was Schutzstaffel. In 1929, the Nazis became an important minor political party.

In July 1932, the Nazis received about 40% of the votes and became the strongest party in Germany. On January 30, 1933, President Paul von Hindenburg picked Hitler to become Chancellor of Germany. During his time as chancellor, he made a plan and took baby steps to become dictator. When President Paul von Hindenburg died, there were no elections for the next president. Hitler just transfer his role of powers to the head of state and became a leader quickly! He controlled Germany with his own power.

World War II started in 1939, Hitler desired more territory. Nazi Germany was allied with Japan, Italy, Romania, Bulgaria, and Austria-Hungary. Hitler invaded western Poland and Soviet Union invaded Eastern Poland. Before the invasion of Poland, Hitler and Stalin had a secret pact agreement to take half the land of Poland. Their pact began on June 22, 1941 two years earlier. So, Hitler and his troopers attacked and invaded the Soviet Union. Nazi Germany annexed Poland, France, Britain, Denmark, Norway, and Soviet Union (Russia). Many countries declared war with German from 1939 to 1945. German surrendered to Russian Troops in April 13, 1945.

The Nazi army, the Storm Troopers, and other people who support Hitler's theory about "cleaning up" the race killed the Jewish people, handicapped, dark hair, dark eyes, dark skin, or everything, which Hitler didn't like. Hitler only wanted to save the people who were blond, blue or green eyes, white and tall. They killed over 18 million people. This mass

execution was called the Holocaust.

At that time, when the Germans lost the war, Hitler's closest lieutenants warned, and urged Hitler to flee to the mountains, but Hitler was stubborn and stayed in the capital town. He believed he would conquer the army and Germany was powerful. So, a few months later, during a meeting, Hitler noticed some person disappeared and started to dismiss the meeting, but some people stayed because Hitler commanded them to. Hitler was nervous because the Soviet Union army wanted to capture and kill him. Russia was in Germany already, and they were on their way to Berlin. The Red Army of the Soviet Union was destroyed in the town where Adolf Hitler was stationed for his job. Hitler managed to escape with his wife to an underground bunker in Berlin. Also, a strange thing is that Hitler brought his dog with them and he used the dog to test if the poison worked. It seemed to work because the dog died. Hitler, and Eva (Hitler's wife) shot themselves, and Hitler also took poison by biting the poison at the same time he shot his head. After a while, the Soviet Union army found them and they were already dead.

With all of the information from the books and the Internet, I learned a lot about Adolf Hitler. Sometimes I wondered if none of it would have happened if the Academy of the Fine Arts accepted Hitler to enter that academy. Its possible WW2 would not have happened. But I prefer not to change the past. That just happened during that time. Sometimes, I felt disappointment when I read about Adolf Hitler 's past and the events of the war. It seems that Adolf Hitler was an angry guy who was searching for revenge. Maybe he felt betrayed by his family or hated himself for some reason or felt hurt because he was rejected from the Academy of Fine Arts. Or perhaps he wanted to show everyone that he could do everything with his power and make a better world.
